“POCKET THE MONEY & SAVE THE PLANET”

The League of Women Voters of the Hamptons is hosting a public forum on ways to save both money and energy.

Titled “Pocket the Money & Save the Planet,” it takes place on Monday, June 13 at 7 p.m. in the community room of Bridgehampton’s Hampton Library at 2478 Main Street.

Panelists will include: Eric Woodward, a Southampton architect, who will speak on “green” home renovations; Rosemary Olsen from the NYS Energy Research & Development Authority (NYSERDA), who will provide information on home energy audits, rebates, approved lists of contractors, and a new joint program with the Town of Southampton; Walter Hoefler, Director of Municipal & School Programs at the Long Island Power Authority (LIPA), who will speak about their Energy Star program; and John Tortorella from Tortorella Pools, who will cover energy-efficient ways to heat your pool.

Information regarding dark sky compliant outdoor lighting will also be provided.

Refreshments will be served at the beginning of the program. A question-and-answer session will follow the panel’s presentation.
