

5) * **3:20-3:50 p.m.** Turn right on Springs-Fireplace Rd., pass Pollock-Krasner House on right, immediate left onto Fort Pond Blvd. At Three Mile Harbor Rd. turn right, then quick left onto Flaggy Hole Rd., then left on Maidstone Park Rd., driving down steep hill for **refreshments at MAIDSTONE PARK picnic pavilion on beach.** (Park has a restroom.)

6) * **4-4:30 p.m.** From park, drive back and turn right (south) onto Three Mile Harbor Rd. Go about 1.5 miles. Turn right on Squaw Rd. at green sign, for talk by Jess Frost, director of **DUCK CREEK FARM HISTORIC SITE and the John Little Barn**, at 127 Squaw Rd., now used for free summer concerts, art exhibits, and weekly Pollock-Krasner House art lectures. See art exhibit by Hiroyuki Hamada. Receive handouts on upcoming summer events.
