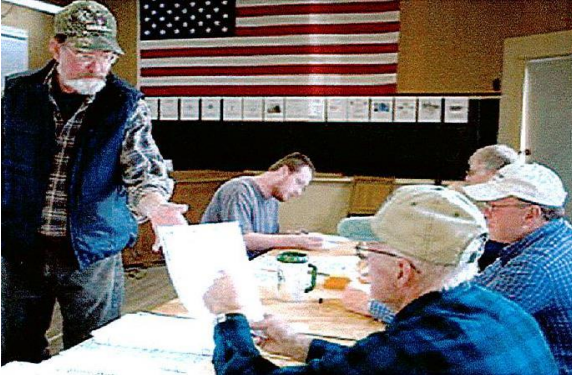


HOW TO VOTE ON THE NEW VOTING SYSTEM

Here is a step-by-step preview of the machine and how one will be able to cast his or her ballot:



1. PAPER BALLOT: When a voter enters the polling place, they will be handed a scannable ballot.

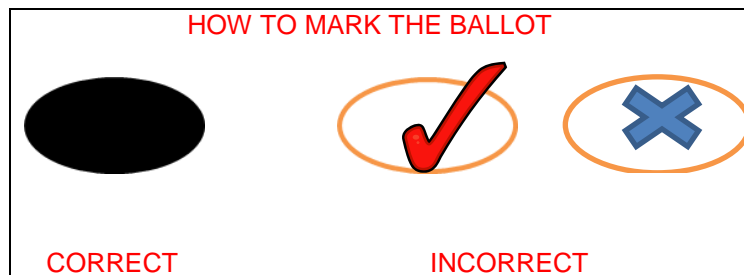
2. FILL OUT FORM: Ballots will be filled out in a privacy booth with a special marking pen.

REMEMBER

Don't fold form

Avoid stray marks on the ballot

Don't cross out incorrect or changed votes; get a new ballot



3. CAST BALLOT: The voter will then take the ballot out of the privacy sleeve and feed it into the scanning machine.

If everything is filled out correctly on the ballot, the scanning machine will read 'Ballot Successfully Cast.'
